

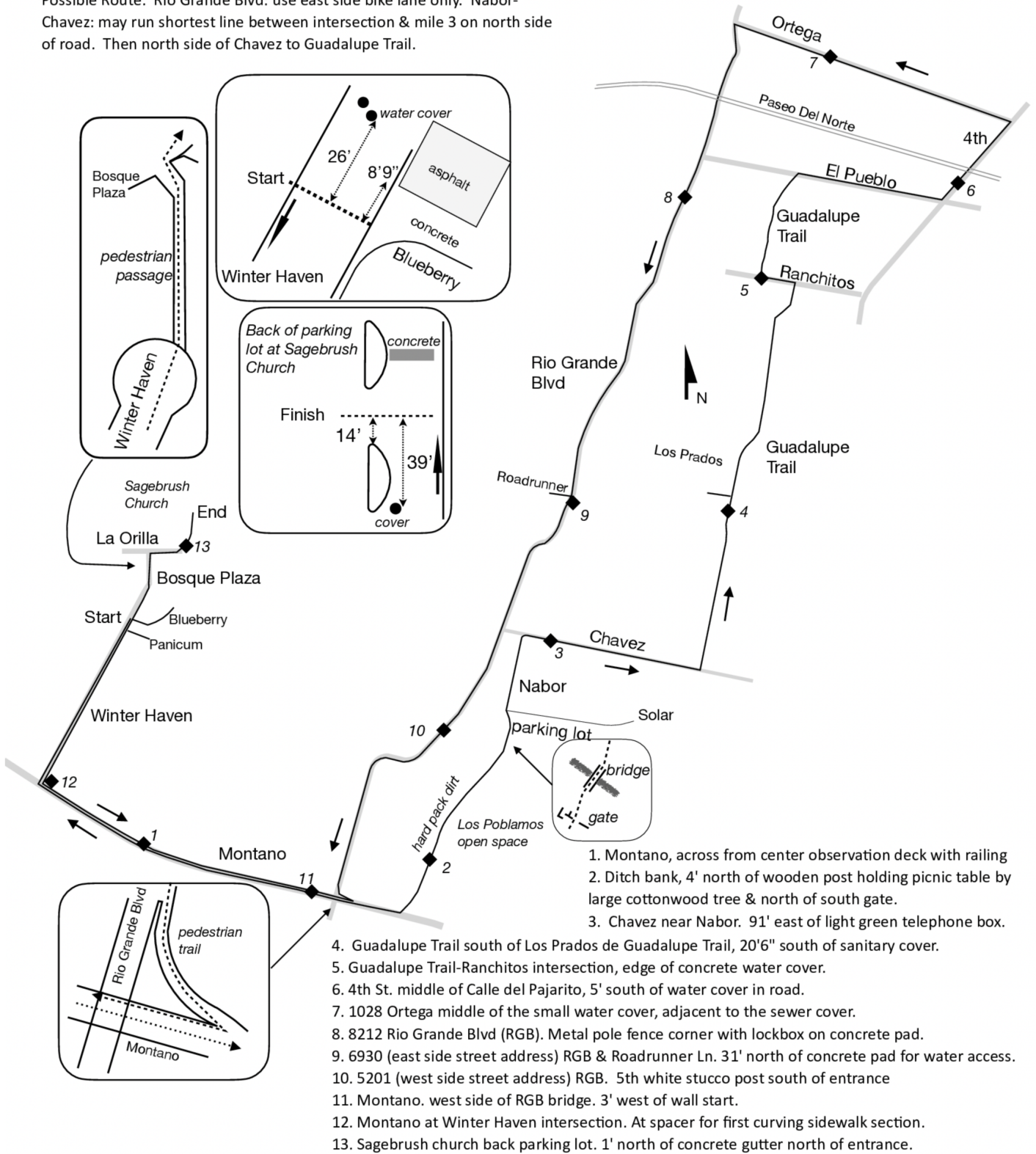

This course was measured using the full width of the road and the Shortest Possible Route. Rio Grande Blvd: use east side bike lane only. Nabor-Chavez: may run shortest line between intersection & mile 3 on north side of road. Then north side of Chavez to Guadalupe Trail.



1. Montano, across from center observation deck with railing
2. Ditch bank, 4' north of wooden post holding picnic table by large cottonwood tree & north of south gate.
3. Chavez near Nabor. 91' east of light green telephone box.
4. Guadalupe Trail south of Los Prados de Guadalupe Trail, 20'6" south of sanitary cover.
5. Guadalupe Trail-Ranchitos intersection, edge of concrete water cover.
6. 4th St. middle of Calle del Pajarito, 5' south of water cover in road.
7. 1028 Ortega middle of the small water cover, adjacent to the sewer cover.
8. 8212 Rio Grande Blvd (RGB). Metal pole fence corner with lockbox on concrete pad.
9. 6930 (east side street address) RGB & Roadrunner Ln. 31' north of concrete pad for water access.
10. 5201 (west side street address) RGB. 5th white stucco post south of entrance
11. Montano. west side of RGB bridge. 3' west of wall start.
12. Montano at Winter Haven intersection. At spacer for first curving sidewalk section.
13. Sagebrush church back parking lot. 1' north of concrete gutter north of entrance.

Albuquerque Half Marathon Markers

Start: Winter Haven and Blueberry. Blueberry is a combination of concrete periphery and asphalt center. Start is 8'9" south of south concrete-asphalt junction, 26' south of the nearest water cover on Winter Haven.

End: Back of Sagebrush Church parking lot between two concrete pads marking parking. A concrete strip crosses the north one. The finish line is 14 feet north of the south pad and 39 feet north of the sanitary cover center.

Rio Grande Blvd. Course marked on east side bike lane.

Nabor to Chavez. Course marked for shortest route between the intersection and mile 3. East of mile 3 the shortest route is along the north side of Chavez to Guadalupe trail.

Miles

1. Montano, across from center observation deck with railing
2. Ditch bank, north of south gate by large cottonwood tree and picnic table. 4' north of wooden post holding picnic table.
3. Chavez near Nabor. 91' east of light green telephone box.
4. Guadalupe Trail south of Los Prados de Guadalupe Trail, 20'6" south of sanitary cover.
5. Guadalupe Trail and Ranchitos intersection edge of concrete water cover
6. 4th St. middle of Calle del Pajarito, 5' south of water cover in road.
7. 1028 Ortega at the water cover, beside the sewer cover
8. 8212 Rio Grande Blvd. Metal pole fence corner with lockbox and pad.
9. 6930 (east side street address) RGB & Roadrunner Ln. 31' north of concrete pad for water access.
10. 5201 (west side). 5th white stucco post south of entrance
11. Montano. west side of Rio Grande Blvd bridge. 3' west of wall start.
12. Montano at Winter Have. At spacer for first curving sidewalk section.
13. Sagebrush church back parking lot. 1' north of concrete gutter across driveway
