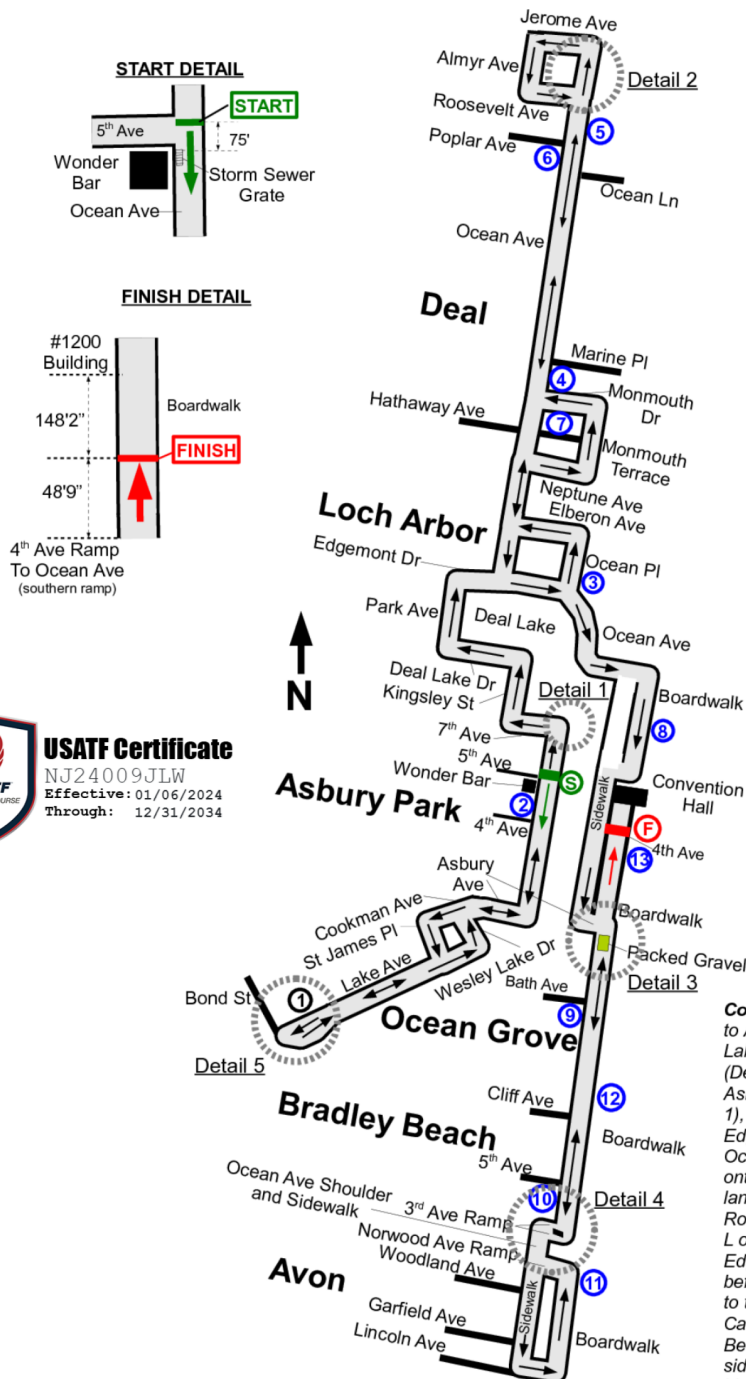

Mile Markers

Mile 13: [40.220629, -73.999663](#) | On the Asbury Park Boardwalk (wood), even with the middle door (of the three) for *Low Dive* (1000 Ocean Ave N, Asbury Park).

Course Description: Start on Ocean and 5th Ave in Asbury, to Asbury Ave, L onto Cookman, L onto St James Pl, R onto Lake Ave, left into parking lot before Bond, through the lot (Detail 5) and right onto Lake, L onto Wesley Lake Dr, R onto Asbury Ave to Ocean, past Start to 7th Ave circle (see Detail 1), to Kingsley, R onto Kingsley, L onto Deal Lake Dr, R onto Edgemont Dr, L onto Ocean Pl, L onto Elberon Ave, R onto Ocean Ave, R onto Neptune, L onto Monmouth Terrace, L onto Monmouth Dr, R onto Ocean, stay in the northbound lane to Roosevelt-taper (move left-see Detail 2) from Roosevelt to Jerome in the southbound lane, L onto Jerome, L onto Almyr, L onto Roosevelt, R onto Ocean, L onto Edgemont, to Ocean, L onto boardwalk, R at the last ramp before Convention Hall onto the sidewalk, follow the sidewalk to the last ramp (Asbury Ave), L up the ramp, R around the Casino (see Detail 3), stay on boardwalk until 3rd Ave Bradley Beach (see Detail 4), L onto shoulder of Ocean, L onto sidewalk at Norwood Ave ramp, remain on sidewalk to Lincoln Ave, L up ramp at Lincoln at the bathrooms, L onto boardwalk, L down ramp to sidewalk past Avon Pavilion, stay on sidewalk to 3rd Ave Bradley (see Detail 4), L onto Boardwalk stay on Boardwalk, through Bradley Beach, Ocean Grove & into Asbury, to Finish on Boardwalk just past southern 4th Ave ramp and the 1100 building on Ocean Ave.
