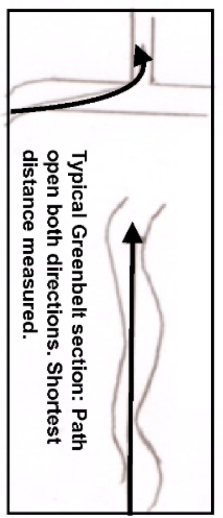
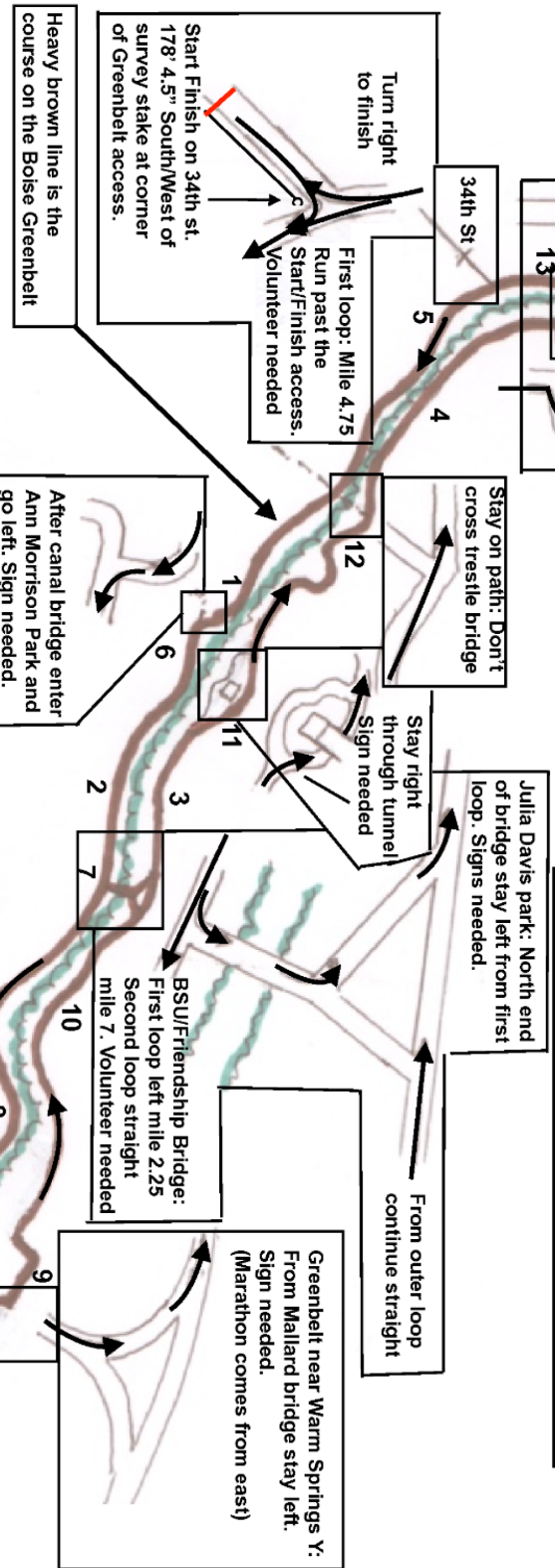


White Water Bridge: Stay left. Separated by rails. Turn left on west end (Crosses twice, first loop mile 4.6 and at mile 13. Signs needed)

Mile Marks: The Boise Marathon (HALF)

Mile marks used for course signage and reference. All points are on Boise Greenbelt.

Start) Garden City 34th St. 178' 4.5" SW of survey stake at the corner of the Greenbelt entrance

Mile 1) South side of Greenbelt at corner of "Rivers United" building 200' before going under Americana blvd.

Mile 2) 50' Before pedestrian circle east end of Morrison Performing arts building.

Mile 3) North side of Greenbelt heading west 60' before mile 0.3 mark

Mile 4) Bench on left side of path between Fairview and Main streets

Mile 5) South side of river behind Riverside Hotel. 34' 9" before fire hydrant on left side of path

Mile 6) In Ann Morrison park. 80' East of bike rack next to parking lot

Mile 7) Corner where new asphalt meets old concrete past Parkcenter bridge

Mile 8) South end of Mallard (orange) bridge

Mile 9) North side of river, 150' before mile NE 2.0 behind waste water treatment plant

Mile 10) East 1591 11" from mile NE 1.0 before Broadway Blvd

Mile 11) West side of 9th St bridge where path splits to road

Mile 12) at "1923" trestle bridge after Firefighters Memorial

Finish) Same as start, 178' 4.5" SW of survey stake at the corner of the Greenbelt entrance

The Boise Marathon (HALF)

Description: Course starts on 34th St in Garden City. Start is located 178' 4.5" from Greenbelt access. Measure from survey stake at corner of path. Course turns right on path to the south, south east. Continue east into Boise on south of Greenbelt to BSU/Friendship bridge and turn left into Julia Davis Park. Stay left and continue west on north side of Greenbelt along river. Stay on main path to White Water park bridge and go left over bridge. Entering Greenbelt on south side run past the Start/Finish area (mile 4.75).

Stay on south side Greenbelt again. This time runners will run past the BSU/Friendship bridge and continue on south side of river to the Mallard (orange) Bridge. Turn left (north) on bridge and continue to Warm Springs area of the Greenbelt. Stay left at the Y, and run West on the north side of the river through Municipal park and back to Julia Davis park.

The path will rejoin the first loop at the "Y" in the path north of the BSU/Friendship bridge. Runners continue on north side of Greenbelt and follow the same path as run earlier to the White Water bridge.

Runners cross the White Water bridge the second time and again turn left on Greenbelt. Runners then turn right onto 34th street and proceed to finish.
