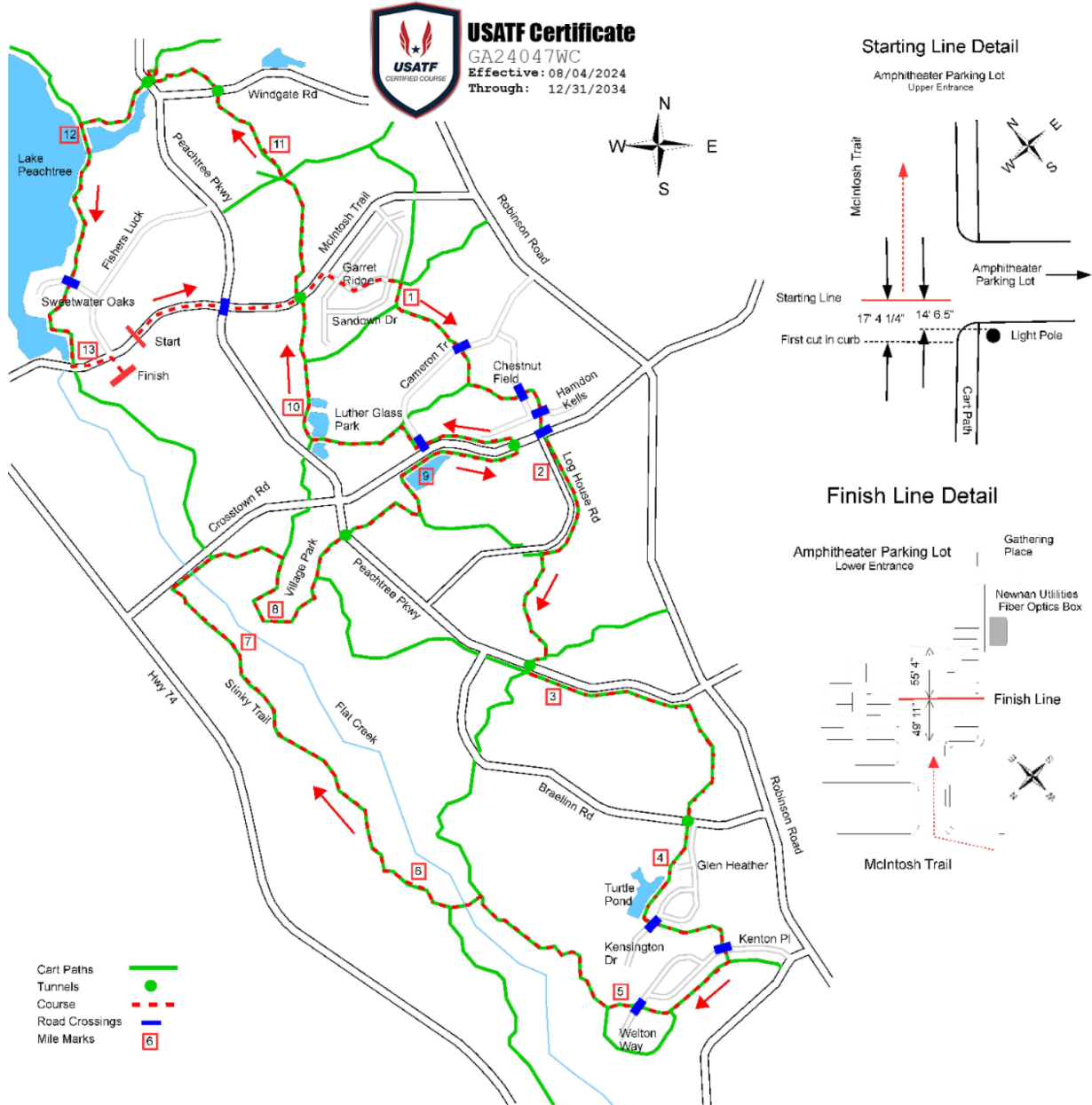

Peachtree City Rotary Half Marathon Course Map Peachtree City Georgia

Start Location: The course starts at the upper entrance to the Fredrick Brown Amphitheatre parking lot and goes northeast on McIntosh Trail. The starting line is 14' 6.5" in the direction of travel from the light pole on the southwest corner of the intersection of McIntosh Trail and the upper entrance to the Amphitheatre. This is also 17' 4.25" from the first curb cut in the McIntosh Trail curb southwest of the entrance to the Amphitheatre.

Finish Location: The finish is in the parking lot at the lower entrance to the Fredrick Brown Amphitheatre. The line is 49' 11" beyond the curb where it widens for the first parking space on the right. The line is also 55' 4" from the closest edge of the Newnan Utilities fiber optic box in the ground on the right side between the finish line and the sidewalk entrance to the Gathering Place.

Mile Locations:

1. On the cart path 78 feet past the sewer manhole behind 305 Sandown Drive.
2. On the cart path along Log House Road 96 feet past the south entrance to the Oak Grove Elementary parking lot.
3. On the cart path along Peachtree Parkway 115 feet past the side path to Pinehurst Drive.
4. On the cart path 37 feet before the sewer manhole behind 204 Glen Heather.
5. On the cart path 246 feet past the Welton Way crossing.
6. On the Stinky Trail cart path 156 feet past the first sewer manhole past the side path to Parkdale Court.
7. On the Stinky Trail cart path at the sewer manhole behind the south end of the Hoshizaki building. The trees block the view of Hoshizaki so you will need your phone or other gps map to locate this one.
8. On the cart path around Village Park behind 2069 Village Park Drive.
9. On the cart path along Crosstown Drive 268 feet before the drinking fountain at Rockspray Pond Park.
10. On the cart path 120 feet past the drinking fountain at Luther Glass Park.
11. On the cart path behind 119 Fountain Head, 425 feet past the Five Points path intersection.
12. On the cart path 83 feet past the turn onto the path along Lake Peachtree.
13. On McIntosh Trail across the street from the Public Works department 40 feet before the second water valve cover in the cart path (the one closest to the street).
