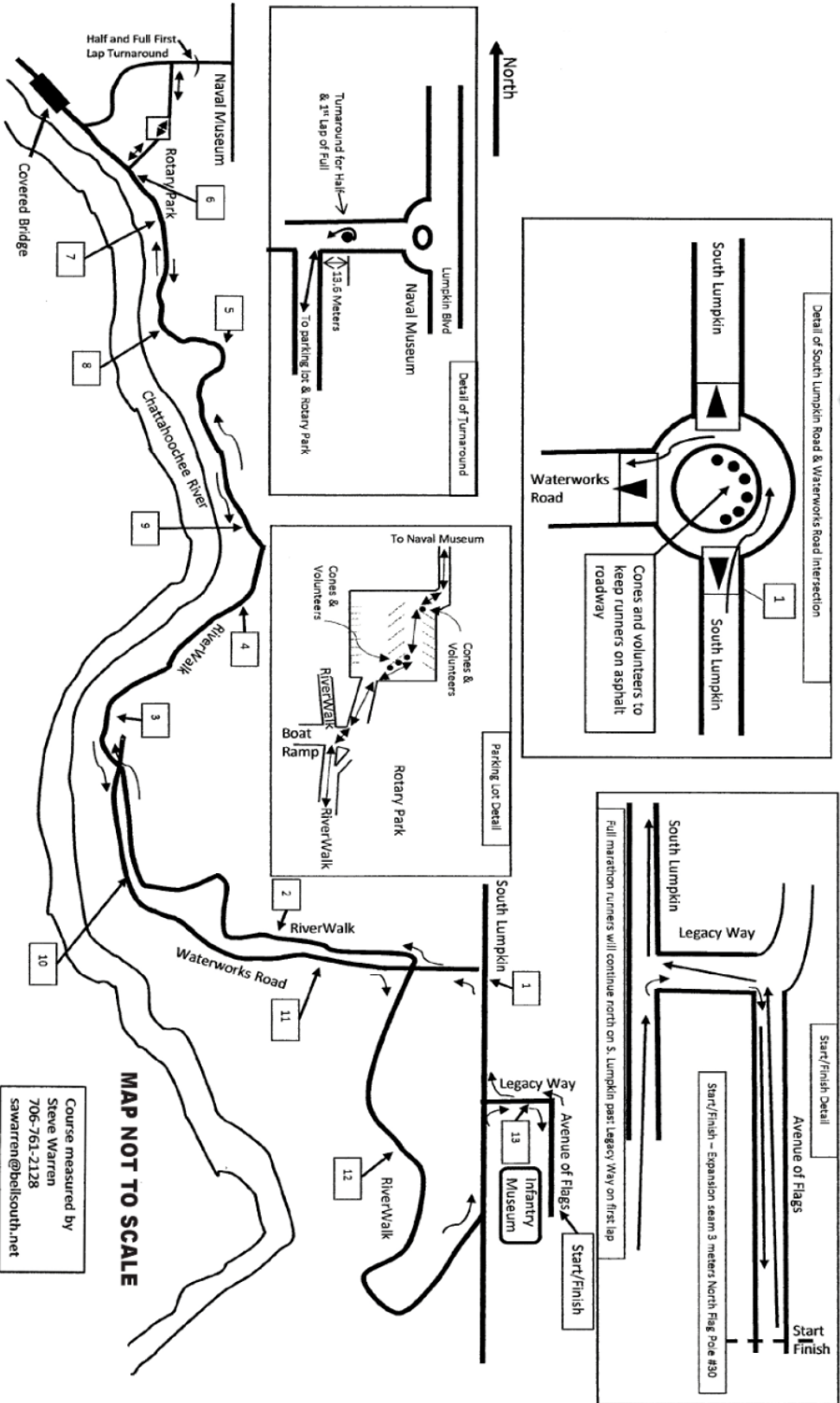

Heroes Of America Half Marathon (Off Base Alternate)

Columbus, GA

Start – The expansion seam approximately 3 meters North of Flag Pole #30 on the Avenue of Flags.

Note: Runners will run North to the end of the Avenue of Flags, turn left (West) on Legacy Way, run to South Lumpkin Road, and turn right (North) onto South Lumpkin Road.

Mile 1 – On South Lumpkin Road 5 meters past the start of the divider for the traffic circle at the intersection with Waterworks Road. Marked with a nail and a washer.

Note: Runners will proceed counter clockwise around the traffic circle in the normal path of traffic. Cones and volunteers will keep the runners on the paved asphalt portion of the traffic circle. Runners will proceed East on Waterworks Road. At the intersection of Waterworks Road and the Riverwalk the runners will take a slight right turn onto the Riverwalk, continuing East.

Mile 2 – On the Riverwalk 16 meters North of light pole # 510, 14 meters South of light pole #509. Marked with a nail and a washer.

Note: At the north intersection of the Riverwalk and Waterworks Road the runners will continue North on the Riverwalk.

Mile 3 – On the Riverwalk 1.4 meters North of light pole #457. Marked with a nail and a washer.

Mile 4 – On the Riverwalk 0.8 meters South of light pole #404. Marked with a nail and a washer.

Mile 5 – On the Riverwalk bridge over Weracoba & Bull Creeks at the 12th I-beam upright supporting the guard rail, 24 meters past the start of the bridge. Not marked.

Mile 6 – On the Riverwalk 13 meters North of light pole #300, 20 meters South of light pole #799. Marked with a nail and a washer.

Note: At the Boat Ramp at Rotary Park Runners will veer right toward the parking lot at Bulldog Bait & Tackle. Runners will run through the parking lot onto the path at the far end. Runners will turn right at the path toward the Naval Museum. The Half Marathon turnaround is 13.6 meters after turning onto the path to the Naval Museum. Cones and volunteers will direct Runners counter clockwise around the turnaround. After the turnaround Runners will follow the same route back to the Riverwalk and proceed south on the Riverwalk.

Mile 7 – On the Riverwalk 14 meters South of light pole #318, 16 meters North of light pole #319. Marked with a nail and a washer.

Mile 8 – On the Riverwalk 3 meters North of light pole #371. Marked with a nail and a washer.

Mile 9 – On the Riverwalk 6 meters South of light pole #423, 24 meters North of light pole #424. Marked with a nail and a washer.

Note: When the runners reach the North intersection of the Riverwalk and Waterworks Road they will turn right onto to Waterworks Road.

Mile 10 – On Waterworks Road 28 meters South of light pole #474, 6 meters North of light pole #475. Marked with a nail and a washer.

Mile 11 – On Waterworks Road 9 meters South of light pole #531, 21 meters North of light pole #532. Marked with a nail and a washer.

Note: When the runners reach the South intersection of Waterworks Road and the Riverwalk they will turn right onto the Riverwalk.

Mile 12 – On the Riverwalk 22 meters South of light pole #583, 7 meters North of light pole #584. Marked with a nail and a washer.

Note: When the runners reach the intersection of the Riverwalk and South Lumpkin Road they will turn left (North) onto South Lumpkin Road. Prior to Legacy Way cones and volunteers will separate full marathon runners from half marathon runners. When the half marathon runners reach the Legacy Way entrance to the Infantry Museum they will turn right (East) onto Legacy Way.

Mile 13 – On Legacy Way in front of the Infantry Museum 23 meters from the center of the Avenue of Flags walkway. Not marked.

Note: Runners will turn right (South) onto the Avenue of Flags toward the Start/Finish line.

Finish – The expansion seam approximately 3 meters North of Flag Pole #30 on the Avenue of Flags.
