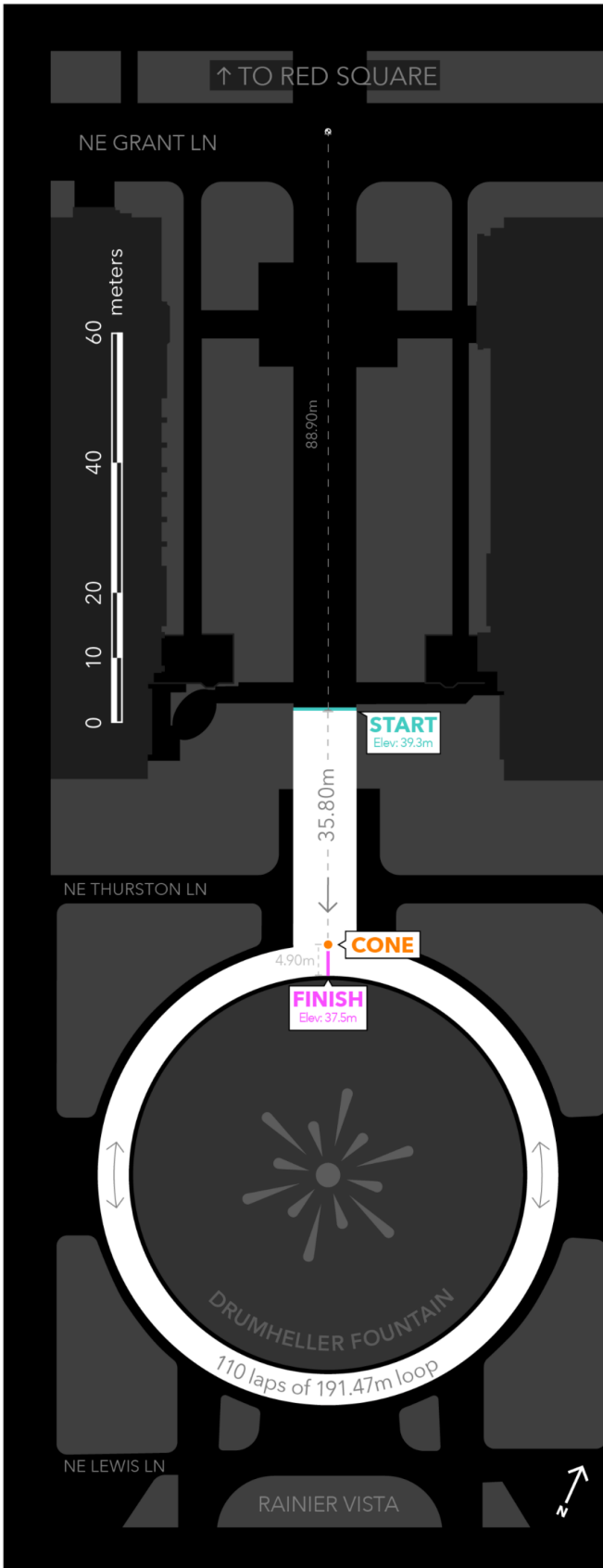

DRUMHELLER HALF MARATHON

21.0975m = 110 laps + 35.80m
University of Washington
Seattle, WA

The **START** is 35.80m north of the edge of the concrete slab encircling the fountain, or 88.90m south of the south edge of the UW control point cover. Runners complete 110 laps of the fountain loop, which measures 191.47m in circumference at 30cm from the curb.

The **FINISH** is the imaginary line that extends from the center of the plaque on the north curb of the fountain.

A **CONE** must be placed at the edge of the concrete pad 4.90m away from the fountain along the finish line.

Restrictions

Runners must enter the loop east of the cone if they wish to run counterclockwise, and from the west otherwise.

Runners may change direction. Only complete laps may be counted.

This course was measured using the full width of the road and the Shortest Possible Route (SPR).

Measured by Nick Walker on April 9th, 2024 using the Calibrated Bicycle Method with 320.0325m calibration course WA23018RMB.
