The event takes place mostly on park paths, except a small portion of the first loop, where city streets are used. Participants may use all of path indicated. The athletes pass through the S/F, going the same direction during each loop. The first loop (3.552km) is completed once. The 2nd & 3rd loop are identical, each containing an out/back section (862m). Very flat course.
